## 1. Important information and who we are

### Purpose of this cookie policy

This policy gives you information about the cookies and similar technologies we use on [www.street-boy-story.com](http://www.street-boy-story.com) and related webpages, shop pages, forms and features (the **website**), the purposes for which we use them, how long they remain on your device, and how you can control them.

It should be read alongside our Privacy Policy and any cookie banner or preference tool displayed when you first visit the website.

### Controller

STREETBOYLIFE STORY LIMITED is responsible for this website and for decisions about the cookies and similar technologies used through it. In this policy, **we**, **us** and **our** mean STREETBOYLIFE STORY LIMITED.

## 2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your computer, tablet, mobile phone or other device when you visit a website. They allow the website (or a third party) to recognise your device and remember information about your visit.

Cookies can be **session cookies**, which expire when you close your browser, or **persistent cookies**, which remain on your device for a set period or until deleted.

We may also use similar technologies such as local storage, tags, pixels or scripts. For simplicity, we refer to all of these as **cookies** unless the context requires otherwise.

### Cookies can also be described as:

- **First-party cookies** – set by us or by our website platform on our behalf.
- **Third-party cookies** – set by service providers such as payment providers.
- **Strictly necessary cookies** – required for the operation, security and core functionality of the site.
- **Optional cookies** – used for analytics, preferences, advertising or similar purposes where consent is required.

### 3. The types of cookies we use

This website uses **strictly necessary cookies** and **optional cookies**. Strictly necessary cookies enable core website functionality, security and the webshop/checkout features you request. Optional cookies support additional functionality and analytics.

Category	Purpose	Typical examples on this website	Consent position
Strictly necessary	To operate the site, keep it secure, process page requests, protect forms, remember basic session information and enable core shop/checkout functionality.	Platform cookies, security cookies, shopping cart session cookies, account login cookies, checkout and payment cookies (PayPal).	These do not require consent where genuinely necessary for the service you request.
Optional	To understand how visitors use the site, improve performance and measure engagement.	Webador analytics cookies and similar platform analytics tools.	Consent required before placement.

### 4. How and why we use cookies on this website

The website is hosted on the Webador platform and includes features such as contact forms, a webshop, cart, wishlist and business information pages. Cookies are used for:

- Loading pages correctly through the Webador platform.
- Protecting contact forms against spam and abuse.
- Remembering items in your shopping cart or wishlist and supporting checkout.
- Processing payments securely via PayPal when you choose that payment method.
- Storing your cookie preferences so we can honour them on return visits.
- Basic security and troubleshooting.
- **Website analytics** – understanding how visitors use the site, which pages they visit, and measuring engagement through Webador's built-in analytics tools.

### 5. Third-party cookies and similar technologies

Some cookies are set by third parties rather than directly by us. On this website, this includes:

- **Webador** (our website platform provider), which sets cookies essential for site operation, security, webshop functionality **and analytics**.
- **PayPal**, which may set cookies when you choose PayPal at checkout to process payments, perform fraud checks and manage the checkout flow. PayPal cookies are controlled by PayPal and are subject to PayPal's own cookie notices and privacy policy.

We do not control every third-party cookie directly. Where a third party sets cookies through our site, their own privacy and cookie information will also apply.

## 6. How to manage or withdraw cookie consent

**Strictly necessary cookies** do not require consent where they are genuinely essential for the service you request (for example, webshop cookies or PayPal checkout cookies).

**Optional cookies** (analytics) require your consent before placement. You can manage preferences using the cookie banner or preference tool on the website. You can also withdraw or change consent later via that tool, by clearing your browser's cookies, or via your browser settings.

If we add new services or categories of cookies, we will update the cookie banner and this policy before or at the same time as those cookies go live.

## 7. Browser controls

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings. You can usually block some or all cookies, delete cookies already placed, or set your browser to notify you before cookies are stored.

Browser controls are typically found in your browser's privacy, security, site settings or history menus. The exact steps depend on your browser and device.

**Note:** Blocking all cookies may prevent parts of the website from working properly, especially the shop, cart, checkout or forms.

## 8. Consequences of refusing cookies

If you refuse **strictly necessary cookies** through your browser settings, some essential parts of the website may not function. For example:

- Pages may not load properly.
- The shopping cart may not retain items.
- Checkout may fail.
- Forms may not submit correctly.

If you refuse **optional cookies** (analytics), you will still be able to use the website fully, but we will not be able to analyse your usage patterns or improve the site based on aggregated visitor data.

## 9. Changes to this cookie policy

We may update this policy from time to time to reflect changes in law, website functionality, payment methods or other technologies used. The latest version will always be published on the website.

We recommend that visitors review this policy periodically.

Cookie/tool type	Source	Purpose	When used	Consent position / retention
Platform functional cookie(s)	Webador	Core website operation, security and ownership verification.	Whenever you visit or use the website.	Strictly necessary; session or short fixed period per Webador configuration.
Cart/wishlist/account cookies	Webador webshop	Keep cart, wishlist choices and checkout state working.	When webshop functions are active.	Strictly necessary for webshop/checkout; session or short period (e.g. until checkout completes/abandons).
Cookie preference cookie	Cookie banner tool (Webador or equivalent)	Store your cookie choices.	When you use the cookie banner/preferences.	Strictly necessary; up to 12 months so choices persist across visits.
Contact form protection	Webador (built-in)	Protect forms against spam/abuse.	When using contact forms.	Strictly necessary; session or short fixed period.
PayPal checkout cookies	PayPal	Process payments, fraud checks, and risk controls.	During PayPal checkout/return flows.	Strictly necessary for the chosen payment method, per PayPal's notices.

Cookie/tool type	Source	Purpose	When used	Consent position / retention
Analytics cookies	Webador	Visitor statistics, page views, and engagement measurement.	Whenever you visit the website (if analytics is enabled).	<b>Optional – requires consent;</b> retention per Webador analytics configuration.
